Title of the publication: The impact of digital platforms and social media on freedom of expression and pluralism - view of young researchers

The proposed texts do not have to be the same as the titles of the speeches at the conference, but should be related to the subject of the monograph.

Brief summary of the monograph:

The monograph on The impact of digital platforms and social media on freedom of expression and pluralism - view of young researchers addresses the following two issues: 1. analysis of the influence of fake news on the internet with regard to the freedom of expression and pluralism of opinions; 2. analysis of the influence of censorship on the internet with regard to the freedom of expression and pluralism of opinions.

The issue of digitalisation and addressing its possible disadvantages from a legal viewpoint are crucial for Europe in the 21st century. The main aim of this monograph is to enable young researchers to present their research results. The proposed monograph will contain valuable analysis for the theory and practice associated with Fake news and censorship.
