CONCEPT

The conference "Equality in an Ever-Integrating Europe in Specific Terms" seeks to address the cuanced and practical challenges of maintaining equality among EU Member States in the context of deepening European integration. While the European Union aspires to build a closer union that respects the diversity of its members, there are ongoing debates about how this equality should manifest in specific areas. This event will focus on real-world examples where the principle of equality is tested in the functioning of the EU. Topics such as judicial cooperation, intergenerational equality, and the interpretation of EU law by national courts will be explored in depth. The presentations will also address pressing issues such as sovereignty and equality in the context of migration, taxation policies, and foreign relations, offering a closer look at how these policies influence mutual cooperation. Through case studies like the Croatian Constitutional Courts interpretation of EU law and the experiences of former Yugoslav states integrating into the EU, the conference will offer practical insights into how equality is maintained—or challenged—within the Union. The goal is to foster a deeper understanding of how intergovernmental cooperation, legal frameworks, and national identities interact in an increasingly integrated Europe, while identifying optential areas of tension and avenues for policy refinement.
